

## **Establishing Existence of Almighty God**

### **Introduction:**

Establishing existence of Almighty God becomes the essential pavement base for building upwards, towards more complex issues relating to our birth, compliance, death, salvation, resurrection and then finally to the Great Day of Judgement for all human beings. These principles apply to all humans, regardless of: their geographical origins, ethnicity and religious affiliations. Once this fundamental fact has been established, then it follows quite logically to our next elevation, which is the ever consciousness of Almighty God, and which will be as a separate discussion paper.

### **Discussions on Establishing Existence of Almighty God:**

- 1) As already reiterated in previous articles, the principles of time and material do not apply to Almighty God: He has no commencement. He always is and He shall always be. He is vastly everywhere imaginable. His Command is sufficient to create everything from nothing. Almighty God is Great! The Holy Qur'an stipulates that whatever Almighty God desires in His infinite wisdom, He only commands and that process commences immediately, according to His laws on that affair: **HQ2:117** *"Wonderful Originator of the heavens and the earth! And when He decrees an affair, He says to it only, Be, and it is."*
- 2) In further establishment of the immaculate existence of Almighty God, it becomes imperative to lend support with Divine material evidence from the Holy Qur'an. In the Holy Qur'an, there are so many manifestly descriptive and articulately captivating expressions of His names<sup>1</sup>, all of which reflect his immaculateness as Great. Almighty God always existed superlatively (without the beginning), before anything else existed, as the Provider and the Protector, as given at another two verses of the Holy Qur'an: **HQ59:22-24** *"He is Allah besides Whom there is no God: the Knower of the unseen and the seen; He is the Beneficent, the Merciful. He is Allah, besides Whom there is no God: the King, the Holy, the Author of Peace, the Granter of Security, Guardian over all, the Mighty, the Supreme, the Possessor of greatness. Glory be to Allah from what they set up as*

partners<sup>2</sup> (with Him)! He is Allah, the Creator, the Maker, the Fashioner: His are the most beautiful names. Whatever is in the heavens and the earth declares His glory; and He is the Mighty, the Wise.” **HQ35:1** “Praise be to Allah, the Originator of the heavens and the earth, the Maker of the angels, messengers flying on wings, two, and three, and four. He increases in creation what He pleases. Surely Allah is Possessor of power over all things.”

- 3) The Holy Qur’an states at so many places that there is no god but only Almighty God, the Beneficent and the Merciful. Almighty God exists since beyond measures of time as One God only and He shall always exist in absolute Supremacy as One God. Almighty God has singularly created and owns whatever is in the universe and Almighty God is Self-sufficient and Praiseworthy. Almighty God is the Supreme Spirit and does not have any defined material form, yet Almighty God is all so Powerful. These descriptions have been condensed in the Holy Qur’an at **HQ2:163** “*And your God is one God; there is no God but He! He is the Beneficent, the Merciful.*”
- 4) Almighty God cannot be seen with material human eyes or described within limits of human imaginations. This was made clearly evident when Prophet Moses was on Mount Sinai to receive the Ten Commandments and Prophet Moses pleaded with Almighty God to show Himself to Prophet Moses. Almighty God in His absolute fairness, gave Prophet Moses a pre-warning and then demonstrated His All-Powerful existence when the mountain simply disappeared into dust in a flash before Prophet Moses’ eyes and Prophet Moses fell down in a swoon. This event is historically recorded both in Jewish scriptures, and in Christian scriptures. Whereas in the Holy Qur’an, this is most vividly recorded at **HQ7:143** “*And when Moses came at Our appointed time and his Lord spoke to him, he said: My Lord, show me (Yourself) so that I may look at You. He said: You cannot see Me, but look at the mountain; if it remains firm in its place, then will you see Me. So when his Lord manifested His glory to the mountain, He made it crumble and Moses fell down fainting. Then when he recovered, he said: Glory be to You! I turn to You, and I am the first of the believers.*”
- 5) Almighty God has repeatedly made clear to mankind that He is Creator of all and everything, so mankind must worship Almighty God only and must not worship other objects<sup>3</sup>. Almighty God does not have any type of

partner or associate of whatsoever description. Most importantly, Almighty God also does not have an heir as His successor<sup>4</sup>. At the same time, Almighty God has made an ordinance in the Holy Qur'an to Muslims: all Muslims must not in any way insult or abuse other peoples' religions. This stipulation is at **HQ6:108** *"And do not abuse those whom they call upon besides Allah, in case, exceeding the limits, they abuse Allah through ignorance. Thus to every people have We made their deeds seem good; then to their Lord is their return so He will inform them of what they did."*

- 6) Almighty God is Forgiving and Merciful and He certainly loves the dutiful.
- 7) There is the Great Day of Judgement and Almighty God will gather all persons since original creation and then judge them as He (Almighty God) is the sole Judge and the best Knower. Almighty God is the Loving, the Mighty, the Wise, the Beneficent and the Merciful.
- 8) Almighty God is the sole Architect and Designer of the blueprint of life of all human beings, since His immaculate creation of the pioneering couple on Earth, who were Adam and Eve. It therefore becomes logically conclusive that apart from Almighty God, no other person or spirit has any knowledge of the future of peoples' lives<sup>5</sup>. On the contrary, the angel of death most promptly goes into action and carries out the task of extracting the life out of peoples' bodies, only upon the express Order from our Maker, and Who is Almighty God. In some cases, Almighty God does not decree permanent death on some people but He takes those peoples' souls away for a short time only and then He restores the soul till a later date; as in a state of comatose. The body does not decompose.
- 9) Whereas in most other cases the soul is taken away permanently, and the person so affected is pronounced as dead and the material body begins to decompose. This most powerful and fearsome statement has been stipulated in the Holy Qur'an at **HQ39:42** *"Allah takes souls (of human beings) at the time of their death, and of those that do not die (He takes) during their sleep. Then He withholds those on whom He has passed the decree of death and sends the others back till an appointed time. Surely there are signs in this for a people who reflect."* There are other moments, when Almighty God confides in His messengers about certain deaths, depending on certain circumstances of events yet to happen.

- 10)** These are prophetic privileges. This clarification has been expressed in the Holy Qur'an at **HQ72:26-28** *"The Knower of the unseen, so He makes His secrets known to none, except a messenger whom He chooses. For surely He makes a guard to go before him and behind him, that He may know that they have truly delivered the messages of their Lord; and He encompasses whatever is with them, and He keeps account of all things."*
- 11)** The two examples (quoted above), establish scriptural proof beyond any measure of reasonable doubt, which positively establishes that Almighty God always exists as One. Further, that He is in total control of all events on Earth and throughout this universe and within all galaxies.

**Conclusions in Establishing Existence of Almighty God:**

- a) Unless any person's mind has been positively established with existence of Almighty God, then all other manifest descriptions of His Superlative Greatness and His timeless existence would be difficult to grasp.
- b) Almighty God has already established His Superlative Greatness in all of His revealed scriptures, to all communities in this world, through the past 124,000 prophets<sup>6</sup> He commissioned to serve all communities on Earth.
- c) Everybody must be mindful at all times, of the complete cycle in our blueprint of life, commencing with our birth, compliance, salvation, death, resurrection and then the final phase of the Great Day of Judgement, with the final outcomes.

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<sup>6</sup> From names of Prophet Adam to Prophet Muhammad (*pbuh*), a total of 124,000 Prophets (*Nabi*) were ordained by Divine revelations, but directly delivered to them by Archangel Gabriel, as spiritually contracted. Out of 124,000 Prophets, only 313 are Messengers (*Rasul*). Out of 313 Messengers, only 25 have been mentioned by name in the Holy Qur'an. Note: that every Messenger (*Rasul*) is also a Prophet, but every Prophet (*Nabi*) is not a Messenger. All of these 124,000 prophets were regular human beings who must eat food, drink water, breath air and need atmospheric pressure to stay alive. The figure of 124,000 prophets is quoted in Hadith No 21257 of *Musnad ibn Hanbal*. Prophet Muhammad (*pbuh*) was the Last and Final Prophet and after his death in 632AD, that sealed off all prophets of any description whatsoever being ordained by Divine revelations, to serve humanity on Earth. This is stated in the Holy Qur'an at **HQ33:40** *"Muhammad is not the father of any of your men, but he is the Messenger of Allah and the Seal of the prophets. And Allah is ever Knower of all things."* Seal means total shutting off arrival of any prophet of whatsoever description: No new prophet and no re-entry of any of the past 124,000 prophets will eventuate.
